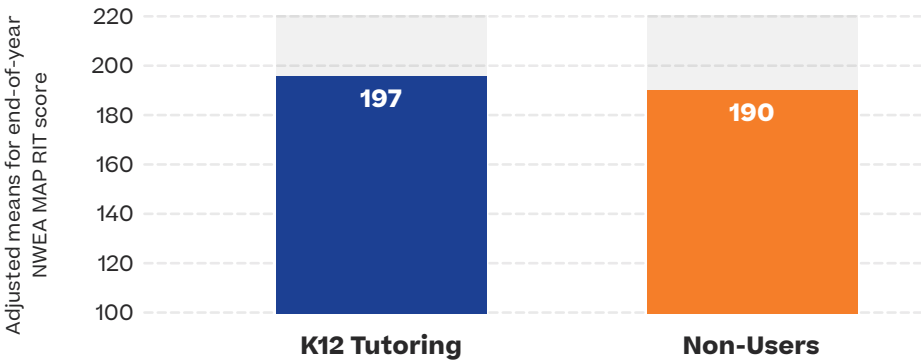


Students who participated in K12 Tutoring scored higher on end-of-year NWEA MAP Growth math assessments than their non-tutored peers.

This underscores the effectiveness of certified educator-led, data-driven instruction in closing learning gaps and driving academic improvement.

K12 Tutoring users had higher end-of-year NWEA MAP Growth math assessment RIT scores than non-users, and this difference was statistically significant.

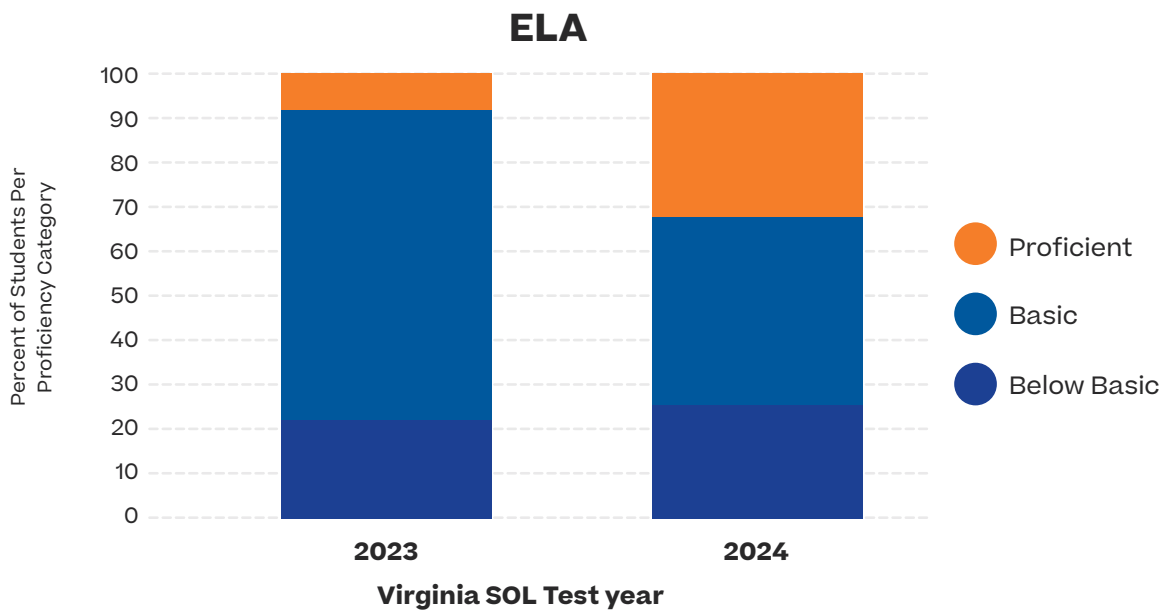
During the 2023-2024 school year, over 800 students in grades 3-8 participated in math and ELL tutoring, achieving remarkable results. While non-tutored students experienced a decline in scores on the Virginia SOL state math assessment, tutored students showed a significant increase, demonstrating a clear shift in proficiency.

Notably, up to 29% of students who received ELA and math tutoring advanced from a “not proficient” status in 2023 to “proficient” in 2024, achieving a passing score on the SOL.

The data also highlighted a strong link between tutoring time and performance, with each hour of math tutoring boosting SOL scores by up to 4.8 points. These results underscore the impact of personalized academic support and the dedication of our skilled tutors.
